Greetings Brethren and Friends,

Visiting and conducting our April Stated Communication at the Scottish Rite House of the Temple in Washington, DC was a wonderful experience. We are so thankful to MW Jim Cole for helping arrange the trip and making it a successful adventure. Masons from nine Virginia and Maryland lodges attended. One doesn't often get the opportunity to tour and to hold lodge in a replica of one of the seven wonders of the ancient world (Mausoleum at Hali-

carnassus or Tomb of Mausolus) and this trip left many lasting impressions on us. Wor. S. Brent Morris 33° presented a fantastic program on Scottish Rite Masonry and if you haven't read his book: "A Complete Idiot's Guide to Freemasonry", then be sure to check it out of our lodge library.

The theme of our May 15th Stated Communication continues with a presentation on the art and history in a lodge not too far from us: Winchester Hiram Lodge No. 21. Visitors from this Lodge will be presenting a program at WSL60 on the history of their lodge and the murals painted on their walls in 1868. Many of the masonic themes portrayed in the murals were duplicated in the WSL60 oil paintings, and I will be traveling to Winchester to make a presentation on our oil paintings at their Stated Communication on May 9. I welcome my lodge brethren in joining me for this visitation.
